- Tested in accordance with the SP standard, NT Fire 017 for fire protection of documents – 60 Paper for one hour's resistance and 120 Paper for two hours' resistance.
- Available in a variety of sizes, the cabinet provides storage for all requirements.
- The cabinet can be customised with a wide range of fittings – including shelves, extendable shelves and lockable compartments – to meet individual requirements.
- Manufactured in accordance with ISO 9001 for quality management systems.
- Slam-shut action ensures that the cabinet still offers effective protection even when unlocked.
- The door is constructed in a similar manner to the cabinet body, ensuring uniform protection against the effects of fire.
- The cabinet is finished in light grey, suitable for most office environments.

Lock Options

The cabinet is fitted with a key lock as a standard. For the monitoring of access to your sensitive data, a series of electronic locks is also available. These range from basic to more sophisticated locks with, for example, an audit trail function.

Testing

The Record Protection Cabinet has been approved in accordance with NT Fire 017 in fire class 60 Paper and 120 Paper. This means the cabinet will protect paper documents for up to one hour and two hours respectively. The certification was awarded by SP (Swedish National Testing and Research Institute).

Test Procedure

Stage 1

The cabinet is placed in a furnace and heated to simulate the effects of a severe fire (almost 1000 °C for 60 minutes for 60 Paper and over 1000 °C for 120 minutes for 120 Paper).

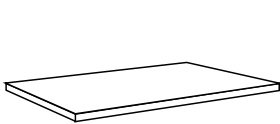


Stage 2

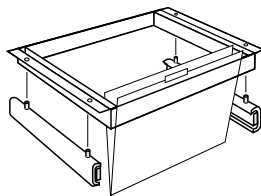
The cabinet is removed from the furnace and cooled. When opened, the inner temperature of the cabinet must not exceed 150 °C.



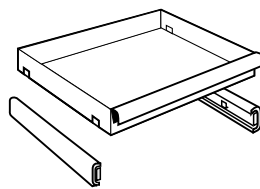

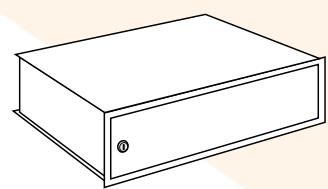
Shelf
