- 1 Ballistic protection to BS 5051/1988, GR2.
- 2 Electrical operation for easy transfer of bullion pallets etc.
- 3 Security ensured by drum design providing constant ballistic overlap.
- 4 Vision panels in the drum allow the cargo to be inspected in the closed condition.
- 5 Visual and audio communication between customer and operator.
- 6 Accepts high sided roll containers and double stacked Bank of England cages.
- 7 Flat through floor for ease of handling pallets.
- 8 Normally installed in one day by our trained service technicians.
- 9 Unit available in right hand operation (as shown) or left hand option.
- 10 Separate document transfer under the vision panel.

The motor-driven Rotary Bullion Hatch is designed for the bulk transfer of valuables from a non-secure area and is used by major UK cash carriers and European banks.

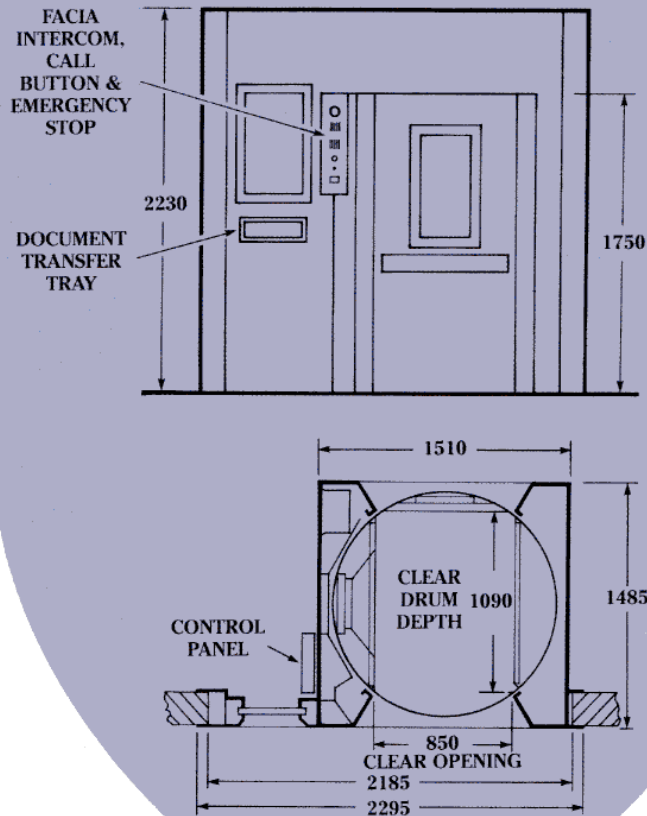
Its operation is simple, safe and secure. The hatch is opened and closed by a controller in the secure area and the operational sequence is such as to prevent the entry of unauthorised personnel, whilst the hatch is in use. The mechanism is fitted with both audible and visual alarm systems.

Installation is easy, as the Rotary Bullion Hatch is a one piece unit and can be installed quickly and simply for your convenience, it has safety features such as hinged flaps on the closing face of the frame and is armoured to British Standard 5051 R2 level and Din Standard C5 Ballistic level and designed specifically for the bulk transfer of valuables from a non-secure zone to a secure one. This Motor Driven Rotary Bullion Hatch is ideal for major financial institutions handling sizeable loads on a regular basis.
